Jesus is the mediator of this glorious New Covenant, which was established and divinely legislated upon qualitatively superior promises far exceeding the Old Testament promises. As the mediator of the New Covenant, he operates in our hearts by the power of an indestructible life to prepare us for God's presence in the heavenly sanctuary, and fits us for the realization of the goals of the New Covenant. He is the person and the medium in which the disposition of God is made effective and imparted to humankind. God's purposes are revealed in the covenants that he enacted with human beings in the course of history. These divine covenants were vehicles for man to enter into God's purposes. They define the inter-personal, intimate, love-relationship that God has always intended to have with humankind. Through the divine covenants God releases his blessings and divine power for man's total blessing and enjoyment. The New Covenant that Jesus ratified in his blood was the long-awaited New Covenant of Jeremiah 31:31-34. This New Covenant is the disposition rooted in the eternal purposes of God for humankind's total blessing. Through the enactment of the New Covenant, humankind has been reconciled unto God to experience the glory of his being and worship him as LORD and king over all.
